

Locating eNCPT Spreadsheet

1. Visit www.ncpro.org and click on the Login button in the corner.

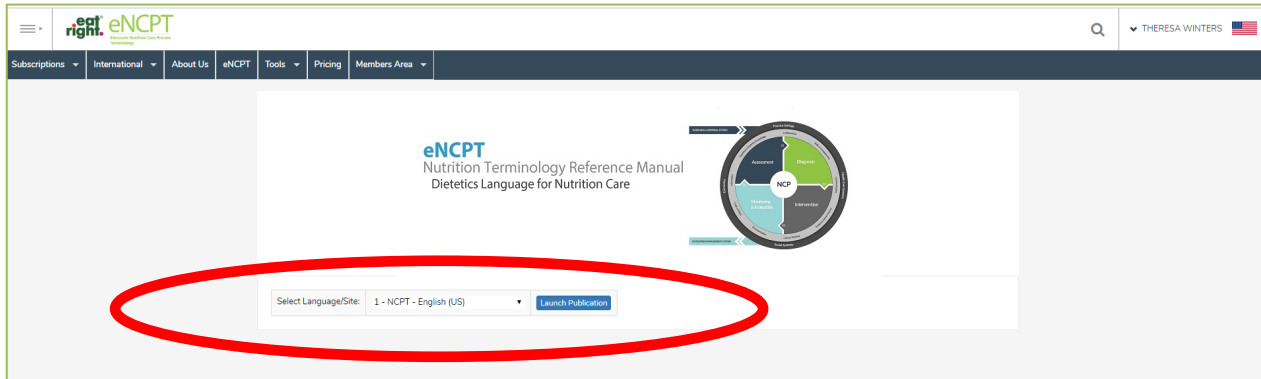


(Use the most up-to-date version of Google Chrome for the best results)

2. Log in with your username and password and click “Sign In.”

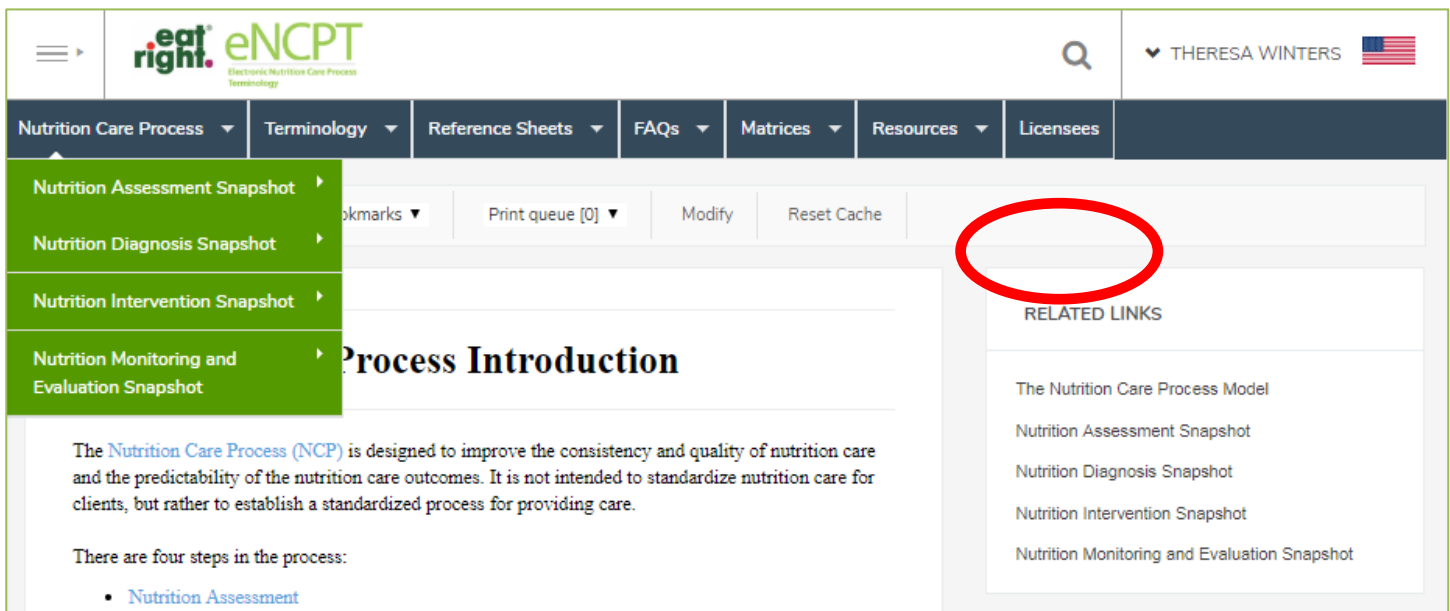

Worksheets and Attributes Contained in this Workbook

Worksheet: e2018 Published Hierarchy

This worksheet contains comprehensive information on this edition of NCPT including the following attributes:

Attribute	Description
ANDUID	Unique Identifier for NCPT terms. This value should be used as a unique identifier for NCPT in information systems. All other values are subject to change
NCPT_Term_w_Context	The full NCPT Term, including enough contextual information to differentiate it from other terms. This term is preferred for use in the electronic medical records.
Pub_Term_Indent	The publication terms with indentation to express the various levels of the hierarchy. This term is sometimes identical, but often contains less information than the NCPT Term with Context.
Domain	Each Nutrition Care Process Term is associated with a step of the Nutrition Care Process. These steps are subdivided into Domains. This attribute indicates the domain of the NCPT Term.
Class	The third highest level of organization of NCPT below Domain.
Level1-Level5	Progressively lower levels of hierarchical organization.
ABRV	Abbreviations for NCPT terms. The AND is no longer supporting the use of these abbreviations, no new abbreviations will be introduced.
Alphanumeric_Sort	This value is used in NCPT to express the relationship of the term to its parents and sibling in the NCPT hierarchy. This value is subject to change and should not be used as a unique identifier in an information system.
NCPT_Type	This value expresses the "Step" of the nutrition care process which the term is used associated with. Current options are: Assessment (A), A
